

What is foster care?

Any number of challenges at home can create health or safety concerns for children. A family court judge often decides it's in the best interest of a child to be removed from their home until parents or guardians get the assistance they need.

Engaging the family unit, our goal is for children to return home with their birth parents whenever possible.

But, in some cases, a child is unable to return home, and becomes freed for adoption.

Nearly 1,000 children in Erie County alone are in need of Foster Care.

Our agency works with Erie County to match children in care with safe, nurturing foster home environments where they are set up to thrive.
