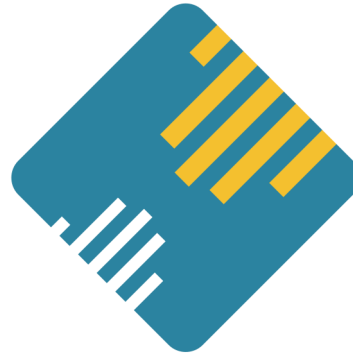

Therapeutic Preschool

A strong foundation for young learners

We specialize in early intervention programs for young learners. Our classes serve toddlers age 2 years and 10 months to children up to age 6.

Evidence-based teaching focuses on creative play and social learning. Parent resources and family support also helps students reach their full potential.

Small classrooms offer structure and personal attention in nurturing spaces.

A team approach

Needs are discussed by the student's family, teachers and social workers.

Working together, we create a plan that builds on the child's strengths. Progress toward goals are evaluated throughout the year.



Educational Services Include:

- 12-month, 215 school day schedule
- Classrooms of 6 students to 1 teacher and 1 teacher-aide
- Certified staff lead each class
- Speech, occupational, and physical therapy
- Health and medical care coordination available
- Parent support through special activity days, conferences, and home visits
- Counseling, training, and support for families in individual and group settings
- Transportation may be available

Our approach is **Solution Focused** and **Trauma Informed**

Our top priority is safety, as well as the social, mental and emotional well-being of youth and families in care. Staff at all levels recognize that each child and family has unique skills and experiences that make them who they are.

Our work builds upon individual strengths, creating partnerships that foster hope for the future. In working together, we engage in collaboration, empowerment and choice.
