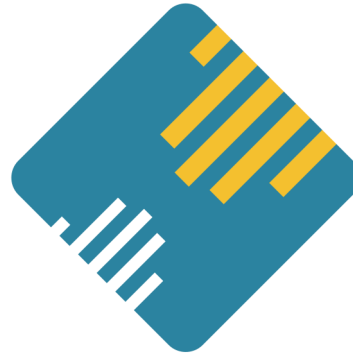




What Our Student's Are Saying

Day School Program

A specialized extension of public school programs

Gateway Longview's Day School Program is designed to provide individualized attention to students ages 5 to 21 with social, emotional, and behavioral challenges.

Our year round program acts as a specialized extension of the student's home school district. Small classrooms with no more than six students offer a high degree of structure, personal attention, and support, helping students succeed in therapeutic environments.

Residential Education

Academics for Campus Residents

Educational services are also provided for all youth enrolled in Gateway's Residential Treatment Services. Run separately from the Day School Program, Lynde School's Residential Education focuses on grades 6-12.

Lynde School's academic curriculum meets or exceeds the guidelines of the New York State Department of Education



Educational Services Includes:

- 12-month, 215 school day schedule
- Certified teacher & teacher aide in each class
- Speech, occupational, and physical therapy
- Individual and group counseling sessions
- Extracurricular and after-school activities
- Community service opportunities
- Job readiness & vocational training

Lynde School is located on our Main Street Campus in Williamsville. Our campus features:
